1. Motion to Approve the Minutes from September 2022 AGM – Approved by Sheila Second by George.

2. Treasurer's Report

6. Proposed Bridge Causeway- The LSSSRA are still monitoring and we will forward us and intern you to any incoming information. They require to inform us of any changes. We will have 30 days to comment before the committee decides.
