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Subject: Update on the Federal Impact Assessment for the Georgina Island Fixed Link Project

Good morning,

I'm writing this email to provide you an update on the status of the Georgina Island Fixed Link Project (the Project).

As mentioned in the correspondence that we sent to you on June 10, 2022, the Agency compiled comments from federal departments, provincial ministries, the public and Indigenous groups into the [Summary of Issues](#) document, which was sent to the Chippewas of Georgina Island First Nation (the Proponent) on June 8, 2022.

On June 22, 2022, the Proponent requested that the Agency suspend the time limit for the Planning Phase of the Impact Assessment process to allow them more time for engagement with Indigenous groups and the public in their preparation of the Detailed Project Description and response to the Summary of Issues. A notice of this time-limit suspension has been posted on the [Agency's Registry Site](#).

Next steps:

The Agency will contact you in relation to next steps in the impact assessment process. After the Proponent submits the Detailed Project Description to the Agency, should the Agency determine that an Impact Assessment is required for the Project, we will be in touch with you again to seek your comments on the draft Tailored Impact Statement Guidelines and Plans.
